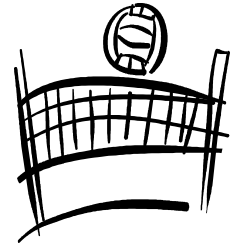

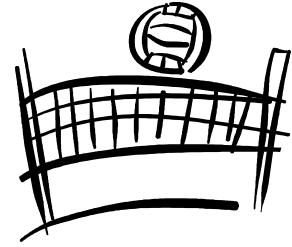

UNITED WAY VOLLEYBALL TOURNEY RULES  
CO-REC SIXES TOURNAMENT

1. Any players playing must be on your team roster. Any teams with players not on their roster will forfeit. No players may be added at the time of the double elimination tournament.
2. This is a co-rec sixes tournament. We will play by co-rec sixes rules. All players must rotate appropriately and there shall be designated front row and back row players dictated by said rotation.
3. Each team needs at least 4 players on the court before play can begin. This may be a combination of 1 man and 3 women or vice versa. No more than 3 men may be on the court at one time. Players may position themselves in any co-ed sixes legal formation. They do not have to position themselves in an alternating man-woman rotation. Although a co-ed tournament, teams consisting only of women will be allowed.
4. Late arriving players may enter a game only under the rules outlined as a substitute player. SUBSTITUTIONS: a substitute may enter the game at the position of center back before the offense's first serve of a volley. This is done after the clockwise rotation is made and replacing the player whom was the previous server. Players may re-enter the game. There is unlimited substitution.
5. Postponements will at the discretion of the referee. We will play in rain as long as there is not the danger of lightning.
6. All games will be played on the honor system. A court monitor will be supplied if necessary or requested. In the event of a dispute where a clear decision cannot be made, a replay will occur. Improper conduct will result in ejection from the tournament without refund of admission fee. Have fun and be respectful.
7. Pool play will be handled best of three games. If two games are won by one team, a third game is not needed.
8. Games 1 & 2 will be played to 21 points. Game 3 will be played to 15 points.
9. Rally scoring:
  - \*When rally scoring is used, every service, except a replay or re-serve, results in a point.
    - If the **SERVING** team wins the rally, that team receives a point and continues to serve.
    - IF the **RECEIVING** team wins a rally, that team receives a point and the ball for service.
    - Rally scoring is to 21 points per game, must win by two points with a 25 point cap. If a third game is played, first team to 15 wins.

10. START OF MATCH: Team will select the order of serve with rock, paper, scissors

11. Rule Reminders:

- The first server of the game is the player in the right back position. Thereafter, when a team is awarded a side out, the player in the right front position rotates to the serving area.
- There will be no blocking or attacking of the serve.
- Kicking the ball is legal.
- Body contact with the net is not legal at any time
